Planning for CNA Social Media

- Discussed overall strategy for adding new social media accounts (e.g. Instagram, Twitter, TikTok, Nextdoor.com, mailing list)
- Agreed to set accounts up as we are ready to use them and get handles that are available at that time
- Planned for the addition of Instagram, as approved at the October board meeting
- Guidelines, policies and procedures for Instagram:
 - Our posts should be related to our neighborhood or contiguous neighborhoods
 - We cannot promote political candidates
 - No religious content (Content about the tenets of any religion are not allowed; however, stories about activities and/or events of religious organizations – and that are open/available to the public – may be published.)
 - We can link to Facebook for the posting rules and regulations
 - Link in bio to Kennedy School Community Room rental
 - Make sure that, if kids are in the posts, we get photo releases
 - Coordinate posts Plan

- Gordon will include Javier when the paper is posted online with that link
- We will work together to include stories to post (same as Facebook), and events that we
 want to be sure to cross promote
- Develop plans for the addition of a mailing list (brought to the November board meeting for approval)
 - Email communication would be once a month, link to the paper, announce meetings and minutes, Kennedy School Community Room rental info, other event info
 - Could be inspired by NECN and AMS
 - Timing for the email newsletter should we send it mid-month as a second reminder for all of the events and goings on, 15th of the month
 - o Sources for email addresses: Media Team list, LUTC list, paper lists, board list

Status of some CNews stories being translated to Spanish

- Spanish version of the Dogwood story has about 20 page views on our website six of those views came from Facebook
- Is there another person that can review the translated story? Reviewing Spanish is beyond the Media Team's skillset. Javier does give the article to his sister who proofreads it for him.

2022 Brainstorming

- Business stories: Priority should go to minority-owned businesses that are new businesses or celebrating significant anniversaries.
